WP6 – Development activities

Call for study visits to the city of Catania (Italy), Budapest (Hungary) and Santander (Spain), aimed at dissemination of knowledge about transfer processes of integrated models for social inclusion of the immigrant population, proposed by the LeCiM project.

Background

LeCiM is a mainstreaming project involving policy-makers, local authorities and public and private stakeholders in projects aimed at policy integration and target actions (support actions for training, job insertion, cultural mediation, housing policies, etc.), which may be identified as good practices at a European level for the social inclusion of immigrants. In this connection, 3 good practices are going to be transferred (from Bologna, Berlin and Dunkerque) to 3 target cities (Santander, Catania and Budapest).

In order to guarantee the best possible result, the project provides for development activities to address an increasing number of stakeholders and cities, which may be potentially interested in adopting good practices in terms of integrated measures for the social inclusion of immigrants.

The project – financed by the EU in connection with LLP programme – is promoted by a partnership of the following organisations: CIOFS-FP (leading organisation – Rome/Italy), DOCUMENTA (Santander/Spain), CEFIR (Dunkerque/France), GSUB (Berlin/Germany), Budapest Észely No profit (Budapest/Hungary), ZSI (Vienna/Austria), MetropolisNet (European Economic Interest Grouping – Associate partner).

Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries of this call are public and private organisations playing a key role in regard to the social inclusion of immigrants, which are also member of European networks addressing this issue.

Activities

LeCiM project envisages 1 or 2 two-day visits for a maximum of 9 organisations to Budapest, Catania and Santander, which will be responsible for transferring good practices adopted locally for the social inclusion of immigrants.

Visits will be aimed at:

- collecting information about the good practices to be transferred
- studying methodologies of transferring procedures
- verifying the need/will to start off cooperation aimed at transferring the above-said good practices to the relevant reference areas.

Requirements for participation

Public and private organisations meeting the following criteria will be allowed to participate:

- minimum 3-year experience with activities aimed at the social inclusion of immigrants
- membership of European networks promoting the social inclusion of immigrants
- for private organisations: connections (through partnerships or cooperation activities) with public authorities

Selection criteria

- 1) Verification of eligibility
- 2) Assessment of CVs: past experiences and partnership agreements – score 1 to 4;
- 3) Score being equal, the order of submission of candidatures will be considered.

Conditions of participation
