The JOBS4ALL project aims to design, develop and pioneer the idea of setting up the **EMPLOYMENT HUBS** for **Young People with Disabilities (YPwDs)** in formal and non-formal environments offering a targeted **EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAMME**.

THE PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

1. Introduce **VR and AR Simulations** in Youth Work to enhance the **employability skills** for YPwDs based on **Gamification** tools.
2. Initiate a **Training Scheme** for Youth Workers (YW) and Young People (YP) on acquiring employability skills.
3. Design a **Policy Advocacy Pack** for the integration of people with disabilities.
4. Set up the **JOBS4ALL Community Hubs**.

TARGET GROUPS

- Young people with disabilities (YPwDs) aged 15+
- Youth workers, Teachers, Educators, SEN Experts, Parents, Social Workers, Psychologists
- Training centres, NGOs, Colleges, Centres for SEN, Policy-makers, Ministries of Education, Enterprises etc.





THE KICK-OFF MEETING

The Kick-off meeting (TPM1) of the JOBS4ALL project was completed online on the 10th and 11th of October, 2022, due to the restrictive measures of Covid-19. During the **online meeting**, the partners introduced themselves and their organizations. Then, they proceeded to the **main objectives of the project** and elaborated on the four Project Results that need to be developed. Finally, the consortium elaborated on the matters that related to the Quality Assurance, Evaluation and Dissemination of the project. The second Transnational Project meeting (TPM2) of the project will take place on the 29th and 30th of March, in Greece.

WHAT'S COMING NEXT?



The project will be initiated with the development of the **"Mapping Tool"**, which will delineate all the available training and employability opportunities for work for YPwDs in all the partners' countries. Following that, the partners will complete **two national focus groups**; one with the individuals that work with YPwDs and one focus group with professionals and businesses, to verify the needs of YPwDs.
